RESIDENT ACTIVITIES DURING AUGUST:

During the month of August, residents were involved in a variety of activities that included: going to the movies at Carmike Cinemas at the mall, going bowling at Steel Valley Lanes, attending God's Choice Church activity in Wellsburg, visiting a local park for picnic, attending weekly concerts at the Fort Steuben, and Weirton Event Center, attending a Washington Wild Things & Pittsburgh Pirates baseball game.

STAFFING ISSUES DURING AUGUST:

Monthly Staff meeting was conducted on 7/30/17. Staff also participated in annual agency MUI make up training on 8/24/17.

Three part time Aide positions were approved for hire during August. Two of these individuals began in their positions. The third declined our offer of employment. Additionally, Michael and Katie Ramey both resigned full time positions at Shaffer in order to relocate to Cincinnati.

RESIDENT ISSUES DURING AUGUST:

As of this writing, two of the three new residents have moved into Shaffer Plaza. The third individual is scheduled to move in Sept. 18th. This will bring Shaffer's census to 29 residents in total.

FACILITY ISSUES DURING AUGUST:

The Ohio Dept. of Health was at Shaffer C on 6/12/17 in order to conduct the annual Medicaid survey. Four citations were issued (none effected client safety & welfare), and a plan of correction was submitted and approved by ODH. The Plan of Correction submitted was approved on 8/17/17.

NURSING DEPT. REPORT FOR AUGUST:

During the month of August, there were 69 total resident appointments: 31 Doctor's Appointments, 19 Mental Health Appointments, 3 Dental Appointments, 0 Podiatrist Exams, 10 Lab Orders, 3 X-ray / US / CT / Mammos, 0 Hearing Exams, & 3 Vision exams.
